- Identify, inform, inspire, and involve prospective/existing large donors and corporate partners
- Find large donors and corporate partnerships by attending and facilitating networking events
- Assist with programming before, during, and after large donor and corporate fundraising events
- Provide in-person, onsite education to corporate leaders and employees as invited
- Collaborate with TYF teams to recognize donors
- Learn and employ various software platforms (e.g. Microsoft Office, Salesforce, etc.)

- Secure event attendees that have the ability to provide major gifts.
- Secure sponsorship opportunities to diversify revenue streams during fundraising events.
- Provide input into the development of a strategic plan for the fundraising campaign(s), including fundraising goals, budget recommendations, vendors, volunteer goals, timelines.
- Actively manage a portfolio of major donors to meet and exceed revenue targets. This will include in-person goal planning meetings with Director of Philanthropy, and Executive Director.
